<p>Create a timeline of poetic movements, ensure that you include poets of the time and at least one example from your favourite time period</p>	<p>Write a poem on a topic of your choice.</p> <p>Success criteria:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) Structure your poem for effect</li> <li>2) Include more than one voice in your poem for effect</li> </ol>	<p>Research the Poet Maya Angelou and create a leaflet informing other students about her life and poems (you may wish to include a poem other than the ones you have studied)</p>
<p>Find a poem of your choice (see websites like PoetryFoundation.org and PoemHunter.com)</p> <p>Make notes on the language techniques the writer uses</p>	<p>Create a revision guide for students that covers all the new knowledge and understanding you have picked up from this term about poetry</p>	<p>Find a song you like (no explicit lyrics!) and copy the words onto a word document where you can then see how many poetry techniques you annotate.</p>
<p>Write your own poem about someone being confused or unsure about something.</p> <p>For instance, you could write a poem about finding it difficult what to do in the future</p>	<p>Write your own poem about someone you admire</p>	<p>Create a mood board of everything that is important to teenagers today- you can add pictures and/or notes. Which topics on your mood board would make great topics for adults to understand teenagers through poetry? Have a go at writing one!</p>
<p>Write your own poem in any style</p>	<p>Make a poster advertising a 'Poetry Slam' you must include names of poets that will perform and titles of some of their work: Make sure you colour it in and make it look presentable</p>	<p>Draw 4 pictures from a poem we have studied and write the quotation next to it</p>
