Founded in 1929, The John Fisher School is a Catholic secondary school which currently caters for over 1,100 boys (to include over 230 in the Sixth Form). Serving the educational needs of the community of Purley and neighbouring areas, The John Fisher School identifies as a centre of learning and wellbeing.

In 2021, 33% of the school's GCSE grades were a 9-7/A*-A grade. 95% of students secured a Level 4 or above in Maths and 91% of students gained at least a Level 4 in English Language or English Literature. At A Level, 54% of grades were A*- A and 78% were A*- B.

In our previous Ofsted Section 5 inspection, both ‘Behaviour & Safety’ and our Sixth Form were judged ‘outstanding’. In our most recent monitoring visit (January 2018) Ofsted stated that the ‘...*steady and reassuring approach ensures the strong commitment of staff...*’ and ‘*the teachers are welcoming and friendly, and it creates an atmosphere where you belong...*’

The school is currently looking to employ a DT Technician to contribute to the provision of practical support for Design Technology in the school. A knowledge or experience of Computer Aided Design and 3D printing would be an advantage.

Salary will be based on experience, in the GLPC pay scale S4 point 7–10. The number of hours is negotiable for the most suitable candidate. The successful candidate will join a dedicated team of staff.
