The school has been provided with a fixed sum of money for its 16-19 Bursary Fund. Once this has been exhausted, no further allocations can be made. Please read "The John Fisher School 16-19 Bursary Policy" for details of the 3 levels of bursary that can be applied for. Level 1 applications will be considered first. If funds remain after the allocation of Level 1 payments, Level 2 applications will be considered. If funds remain after the allocation of Level 2 payments, Level 3 applications will be considered. If funds remain after the application deadline of **Friday, 30th October 2020** then applications can be made later in the year, until no funds remain.

The decision as to allocation will be made by the Bursary Panel. Any and all financial documentation submitted will be kept confidential. The Headteacher and the Director of 6th Form will *not* view any documentary evidence of financial status, but may view page 4 of the application form to determine whether the items the student intends to purchase will support the student's learning.

It should be noted that financial support in terms of cash payment is rare and would need exceptional circumstances documented by clear evidence.
