GCSE & A-level Examinations – Summer 2022

The DfE and Ofqual published a number of documents setting out plans for GCSEs and A-levels. Here are some of the headlines:

- There will be optional topics and content in GCSE English Literature, History, Ancient History and Geography.
- If necessary, centres will be allowed to deliver practical work in GCSE Biology, Chemistry and Physics by demonstration.
- Students taking GCSE and A-level Art and Design will be assessed on their portfolio only.
- Exam boards will provide advanced information about the focus of the content of exams for all GCSE and A-level subjects except GCSE English Literature, History, Ancient History and Geography by 7
 February 2022 at the latest. This could be released earlier 'if circumstances require'.
- Students will be given a formulae sheet for GCSE Mathematics and a revised equation sheet for GCSE Physics and Combined Science.
