Industrial Action - School Closure: Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> - Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> May Message from Mr Paul McCallum, COO, Archdiocese of Southwark

'The National Education Union have initiated a dispute with the Governing Body of The John Fisher School who are the employers of staff in school. The dispute involves fewer than 70 staff at the school. The governing body are working to address the union's concerns; some governors gave a day of their time last week to attend meetings with ACAS and the unions, and will attend further meetings next week. They are committed to addressing the action recommended by Ofsted to restore stability to governance as quickly as possible, particularly for sake of the pupils who are shortly to take important exams.'

## **UNICEF Rights Respecting School Award: Playground Charters**

This week, a group of students who are leading on our UNIECF Rights Respecting Schools' Silver Award, produced and shared a video explaining a new playground charter. Based on the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC) the charter covers 54 articles encompassing all aspects of a child's life, such as the right to be heard, the right to freedom of expression and the right to be safe from violence. The students have then asked every form group to sign up to these articles, stating that all playgrounds will continue to be spaces where students can enjoy these articles.
