Parent/Carer Sessions: Tuesday 21 March and Tuesday 28 March

One of the concerns faced by parents/carers is how they can help their young people feel safe and how they can keep them safe, especially with news coverage and social media fuelling. The Ben Kinsella trust is an educational charity that campaigns against knife crime and helps young people make positive choices and stay safe. They have just launched a FREE online course entitled "Exploitation, Gangs and Knife Crime Awareness". This is a two-part course delivered over two evening sessions on 21 March and 28 March, from 7.00pm until 9.00pm. These sessions are delivered by a former Metropolitan Police Officer and come highly recommended. They are a valuable resource and signposting tool in understanding what is regular teenage behaviour and what is not helping to prevent serious youth violence and exploitation.
