Art Exhibition at Jemca Toyota, Croydon Showroom (Purley Way)



As these are rescheduled dates, there are some staff who are unable to make the dates for a number of reasons including school trips, previously booked commitments and childcare arrangements.

You will be able to see which teachers are available when you access the booking system.

Enrichment Day: Friday 15th July (Years 7- 10 and Year 12)

On Friday 15th, all students in Years 7-10 and 12 will enjoy an enrichment day. The aim of the day is to allow students to explore learning outside of the classroom, developing their skills, readiness for the wider world and cultural capital. You will receive a letter specific to your son's year group in due course with more information, but this is the overview for the day:

Year 7: 'Alternative Sports Day': The PE department will lead a day of alternative sports, allowing students the opportunity to try out some new sports for the first time.

Year 8: 'London Zoo': As part of your son's Science studies we have focussed on the Biology topic 'Variation and Survival' and the Chemistry topic 'Using our Earth Sustainably'. To give the students an insight into these topics, a trip to London Zoo for the whole of Year 8 has been organised by the Science department.

Year 9: 'Take your son to work day.' As part of a week focussed on career advice for Year 9, students are being given the opportunity to attend the workplace of their parents/carers, or close family member. They will enjoy a week cantered on careers, including the 'Speed Careers' event on Wednesday 13th July in school.

Year 10: 'Inspiration': The students will enjoy a mixture of guest speakers, visiting artists and a number of workshops. We will welcome some former students to the school who have gone on to succeed in their chosen field. This includes Akeem Bundu-Kamara who was on the most recent series of The Apprentice.

Year 12: 'Team Building': As part of their Enrichment Week, students will enjoy a day of team-building activities and final preparation for UCAS/Year 13.

Warmer Weather

There is a message on the school website regarding expectations in warmer weather. During this period of warmer weather, we want to ensure our students are well protected from the sun.

Before School:

- Students are encouraged to apply sunscreen before they come to school and to bring this with them in order to re-apply it when necessary. Sunscreen is not provided by the school as some students could be allergic.
- Students should bring a bottle of water to school which can be re-filled.
- Students can wear their John Fisher School caps to help cover their head during PE/Games lessons.

During School:

- Students are encouraged to stay in the shade during their breaks.
- All of the school's water fountains are in use and bottled water can also be purchased from Harrison Catering.
- Students have permission to remove jumpers/blazers. Shirts must continue to be tucked in and all other uniform expectations still apply.

The school will continue to monitor the weather and if excessive temperatures are forecast, then a further relaxation of the uniform could take place to include the wearing of school ties.
