Dear Parents/Carers,

We welcomed the visit from Ofsted this week. Thank you to all parents/carers who sent in their best wishes in what was such a positive process. The students were exemplary in the way they went about their learning and sharing their thoughts during lessons and meetings. Here is a summary of some of the findings which were verbally shared, although the final report will not become available for a number of weeks, as it has to be quality assured by the Inspectorate. Findings include:

- Staff members have high expectations regarding students
- Teaching staff members demonstrate secure subject knowledge
- Teachers present information clearly to students
- There is evidence that curriculum provision is sequenced over time
- Students were calm, focussed and purposeful in lessons
- Students who were spoken to could recall knowledge with detail
- There is a wide range of extra-curricular opportunities
- There are opportunities for student leadership
- Students understand the concept of social responsibility
- Developments continue to take place around equality, diversity and inclusion
- There is effective careers provision which meets the Gatsby Benchmarks and Baker Clause
- There is an experienced core Safeguarding team
- The school has a strong commitment to RSHE
- There is a commitment to mental health and wellbeing
- There is effective provision around the development of reading, to include screening and phonics support
- Students were calm, focused and purposeful in lessons


