Dear Parents/Carers,

Many thanks for all of your support during this half term. It has been a demanding half term and we congratulate Year 11 and Year 13 students on the completion of their Controlled Conditions Tests (CCT's).

We welcome students in Years 7 -10 and those in Year 12 back to school on Monday 7th June for an Enrichment Day. Year 9 students will be starting their assessments from Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> June.

Please continue to report your son's lateral flow test results. The government advice is that everyone tests regularly. For details on obtaining kits for other members of your family please click [here](#). It is important that for the purposes of contact tracing, students, parents and carers inform the school of a positive case. If symptoms develop within two days of being in school (Friday 28<sup>th</sup> May or Saturday 29<sup>th</sup> May), the school has been asked to assist in identifying close contacts and advising self-isolation, as the individual may have been infectious whilst in school. If the school is informed of a positive case we will advise close contacts via email to self-isolate and provide them with further information relating to the next steps. If your son's symptoms develop after two days of being in school, students, parents and carers should follow contact tracing instructions provided by NHS Test and Trace.

Parents/carers of eligible students should have received a Free School Meal voucher to cover the May half term break. This is being funded by Sutton Local Authority.

Thank you to all of the parents/carers who attended the JFA (John Fisher School Association) meeting on Wednesday night. The next meeting will take place on Wednesday 23rd June at 8.00pm.
