## Industrial Strike Action by the National Education Union (NEU), Wednesday 5 July and Friday 7 July

As you will have seen in my letter earlier this week, the NEU has confirmed industrial strike action will be taking place on Wednesday 5 July and Friday 7 July 2023. As a result, there will only be a partial opening for students, please read the letter circulated on Tuesday regarding the arrangements.

If your son is in Year 8 and you have given your consent for him to receive the HPV immunisation, then please see the table below for the time he should arrive at school on Wednesday 5 July. Students will receive their immunisation, be observed for 10 minutes afterwards and then leave site.

- **Students in 8C, 8K, 8M and 8T should arrive at 9.00am**
- **Students in 8B, 8F and 8N should arrive at 10.30am**

All Year 8 students should enter via the back gate and go straight to the Quad.

All Year 8 students should wear Games kit.

All Year 8 students will exit via the back gate.

If your son is in Year 8 and attending the trip to Warner Bros. Studios on Wednesday 5 July, he will not receive his immunisation. The school will communicate arrangements with regards to a catch-up session once the arrangements have been confirmed with the Immunisation Team. Please be reminded that students on this trip, should be wearing full school uniform at arrive to the back gate 8.45am.
