Year 8 Parent Teacher Meeting (PTM): Proposed new date

As you may have heard in the news, the teacher unions are currently balloting members on whether to accept the recent government offer on pay and conditions. The National Education Union (NEU) have announced two further potential days of industrial strike action should their members vote to reject the offer and the proposed dates are **Thursday 27 April and Tuesday 2 May 2023**.

If this industrial strike action goes ahead on Thursday 27 April then the Year 8 PTM which was scheduled for this day will be moved to **Thursday 8 June**. I will be able to confirm at the end of the first week of the next term.

Sixth Form Student Leadership Team 2023/24



