Summer Works

This summer we have been busy enhancing our school site, investing to keep improving the experience for our students. The Sixth Form Centre has had a complete refurbishment and is now a wonderful facility which supports the transition into the world of work and beyond. With a mixture of new study spaces, IT access and a common room, this is now a place our students can be proud of. This would not have been possible without the parental donations which so many of you so generously give each month.







Around school we have improved classrooms, with our investment in IT continuing. We have managed to invest just over £100,000 this year, much of which has come in the form of donated hardware and alumni donations. We have also installed 4 new water bottle fountains which have been welcomed additions particularly in this week's heat. They provide students the opportunity to refill bottles, reducing wastage and helping our environment.



Education Sunday, 10 September

This year, Education Sunday focusses on the promise given by Jesus in St Matthew's Gospel: 'Where two or three meet in my name, I shall be there with them.'
