Inference (4 marks) Question	The students have to answer a 4 mark question in which they have to make two inferences about an issue laid out in the question. Explain (12 marks) Question	The students will be asked to explain how the German people felt about a topic. Usefulness (8 marks) question	The students will be asked to assess the usefulness of two sources that is telling them about a topic organisation. They will need to explain how the source is both useful and limited.
