Research, plan and deliver a speech on the topic of homelessness.	Imagine you are a newspaper reporter. Write a newspaper report about the missing homeless people.	Do you think that there is justice at the end of the novel? Write a persuasive argument about your opinion.
Create an information leaflet that offers advise and support for homeless people.	Create a 15 question quiz on the novel so far. You must include some questions beginning with 'how' and 'why'.	Shelter is on trial. Write an opening speech for the prosecution or defence. accusing or defending him.
Make an advert for a charity to help homeless people. Use at least five persuasive tools. Label the persuasive tools.	Imagine you are Gail. Write a letter to Link, explaining your actions in the story from your point of view.	What happens to the characters after the book has finished? Choose two of them and plot out the events.
Find and print a newspaper article about homelessness. Summarise what it's saying in five to ten sentences.	Imagine you are Link's mum, or Carol, Link's sister. Write a diary entry about their actions at the start of the novel.	Design an advert for the book: this can be a poster, a radio script, a jingle or a leaflet.
